

In Memorian Richard Wiggins


Richard Wiggins, a Pine Bush, N.Y. resident and Garnet Health piano player, passed away on Jan. 16, 2023 at the age of 90. Mr. Wiggins was a beloved member of the Garnet Health family, where he played piano in the hospital outpatient lobby.

"He was a friend to many and a sage to some," said Foundation President William Dauster. Mr. Wiggins, who admittedly could not read a musical note, was a gifted jazz piano player. He was known across Orange County for his musical residencies in many popular restaurants.

Mr. Wiggins traveled the globe for over 20 years as a soundman for CBS and "60 Minutes," winning three Emmy awards along the way. In 2019, Mr. Wiggins hosted a Fireside Chat for the Garnet Health family, walking guests through his CBS international adventures with the help of a piano and his own photos.

Survivors include his loving wife, Selma Wiggins, and his two children, Kimberly and Janice, to whom he was a devoted father. He was also a grandfather to 13 and a stepfather to four: Haydn, Shellyann, Sharon, and Sheldon.



Birdhouses receive much-needed makeovers

The birdhouses in the Lawrence A. Testa Healing Garden - lovingly sponsored by donors around the region in memory of loved ones, beloved colleagues, and special events - are about to enjoy a reinvention.

Predictably, these poor birdhouses have seen better days after being subjected to the outdoor elements for the last several years. However, the Garnet Health Foundation has selected Birdhouse Brokerage, a family-owned birdhouse maker based in Wallkill, N.Y., to take on the important task of creating brand new birdhouses to replace those that are currently in the garden.

"Our birdhouses are lovingly hand-crafted using freshly-milled and reclaimed barn wood, rescued from aging barns found in the scenic Hudson Valley of New York," explained artist Craig Andrews. "Some of our old timbers date back 100 years or more, and are skillfully transformed into unique birdhouses with the charm of yesteryear. Each piece is hand-nailed and screwed together for long-lasting strength. No glues are used in our construction. Because no two pieces of aged wood are alike, each birdhouse has its very own personality. As a result, every birdhouse we build is truly one of a kind."

Birdhouse Brokerage has been featured in several periodicals, including The Washington Post, Rosie Magazine, Hudson Valley Magazine, Better Homes & Gardens, This Old House Magazine, and Country Living.

Garnet Health announces new leadership

Garnet Health is pleased to announce the appointment of Jonathan Schiller as President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) for the health system. Schiller will officially step into this role on June 1, 2023. Jerry Dunlavey will remain Garnet Health's Interim President and CEO, as well as Garnet Health Medical Center – Catskills' Chief Operating Officer (COO) through May 31, 2023. On June 1, 2023, Mr. Dunlavey will become CEO of Garnet Health Medical Center – Catskills.

"Jonathan is returning to Garnet Health after a year away. On behalf of the Board of Directors and all employees, we warmly welcome him back to the Garnet Health family," said Phillip Massengill, MD, FACS, Board chair of Garnet Health. "We look forward to his outstanding leadership abilities in advancing Garnet Health's growth and impact on the communities we serve."

Mr. Schiller comes back to Garnet Health after serving as President and CEO of Oneida Health. Prior to joining Oneida Health, Mr. Schiller was CEO of Garnet Health Medical Center – Catskills. He joined Garnet Health in 2004 and held various leadership positions within the system, including Administrator of Revenue Cycle Management, Vice President and Site Administrator, and Vice President of Hospital Operations, providing organizational leadership to multiple ancillary departments. Mr. Schiller's leadership was instrumental in the construction and opening of Garnet Health Medical Center's hospital in 2011, which included the relocation of Horton and Arden Hill hospitals to the new facility.

In 2013, Mr. Schiller was promoted to COO for Garnet Health Medical Center, where he was responsible for daily operations of the hospital. He was appointed CEO of Garnet Health Medical Center – Catskills in 2017, providing executive leadership for the Harris and Callicoon hospital campuses, as well as system-wide executive support for the Hospitalist, Intensivist, Psychiatry, and Emergency Management services.

"After working a year in central New York, this change reunites my family at home and provides a refreshed opportunity to advance healthcare in the Catskills and the Greater Hudson Valley. To say this feels like a homecoming is nothing short of an understatement," said Mr. Schiller. "I am excited to return to Garnet Health and be part of an organization that works hard to meet the needs of the community and cares so deeply for the patients. I stand committed to serving the residents of Orange and Sullivan counties, ensuring that access to quality healthcare remains a top priority."


